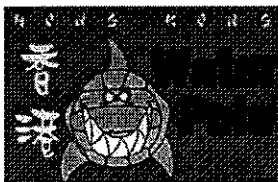

INFORMATION AND RULES

- There will be a Teams Presentation Ceremony at 12:30 on Sunday afternoon. All teams and officials are requested to attend wearing their team uniforms.
- Day 1 1st Round games for Men's and Women's will be 4 X 5 mins stopping clock.
- Day 2 2nd Round and Final Round games for Men's will be 4 X 8 mins stopping clock.
- Day 2 Women's games will be 4 X 5 mins stopping clock
- Teams should be present in the marshalling area 15 mins prior to their match.
- The team first listed will play in white caps and start at the diving pool end.
- Any team not ready to start in the water more than 10 mins after their allotted start time will automatically concede the match 5-0.
- Points for games for Men's in 1st Round and all the games for Women's are as follows; WIN = 3 points, DRAW = 1 points, LOSE = 0 point.
- If there is a draw at the end of any games in the final round, the match will be decided by penalties. (5 different players from each team will shoot in alternate succession). Goalkeepers are allowed to shoot. If it is still a draw a further five different players will shoot. If there is still a draw, remaining players who have not shot will shoot with sudden death. Further shots will be taken in the same order as previous shots. Goalkeepers must be designated at the beginning of the shoot-out and may not be changed during the shootout except due to injury. There will be no extra time for any matches.
- When deciding group standings, teams with equal points will have goal difference counted (i.e. No. scored minus No. scored against), then No. of Goals scored total.
- Any player ejected for brutality will automatically miss the next game with possibility of substitution for that game. 2 or more counts of brutality will result in the player missing the rest of the tournament with possibility of substitution for remaining games.
- All other FINA rules apply incl.: 13 players maximum in any one match.
- Referees must wear the assigned polo shirt and be present on the pool deck 15 mins prior to the starting time.
- Players are not allowed in the VIP area.
- All players & officials should wear the Accreditation Card provided by the organizing committee throughout the tournament.
